Winners receive a lifelong Fellowship that includes up to \$5,000 in seed funding for your social venture, dedicated mentorship, and access to a wide network of people and resources that will help further your impact.

HOW IT WORKS

Any currently enrolled undergraduate with an idea to create a social venture (either for-profit or not-for-profit) must register by Thursday, March 7, 2024.

Students complete Resolution's online application by Thursday, March 21, 2024.

Resolution Project reviews applications and a select few will be invited to pitch their social innovation at our multi-staged pitch challenge on April 12 & 13 in Newark.

Resolution Fellowships are awarded to the most compelling leaders with the most promising proposals!

OUR FELLOWSHIP PROVIDES

Seed Funding: A grant to kick-start your social venture, between \$1,500—\$5,000.

Strong Advisory Support: Each team is assigned a pair of Guides, providing mentorship ranging from social venture advice to professional development.

Access to Resources: A diverse array of trainings, networking, and professional services to help navigate the challenges of social entrepreneurship.

Community: Access to advisors, socially responsible supporters, and an action-oriented peer group.
