On behalf of the Board of Directors, we are pleased to announce that New Jersey Health Foundation is launching the annual cycle of our Grant Program. Our Research grant program supports grants up to \$50,000 and our Community Health, Behavioral and Social Science, Social Service & Education grant program supports grants up to \$35,000. We have allocated up to \$5 million in funding for this current cycle of our programs.

The New Jersey Health Foundation Research Grants program supports early innovative research projects that demonstrate exciting potential and help researchers qualify for larger grants. Our Community Health, Behavioral and Social Science, Social Service & Education Grants Program funds health-related community, education and social service projects as well as behavioral and social science projects that address issues impacting society.

Applications will be accepted from **September 13 through November 8, 2024**, through our grant portal. Full-time faculty members, staff and other personnel at these organizations are eligible to apply for grants of up to \$50,000 each under the Research Grant Program and up to \$35,000 each under the Community Health, Behavioral and Social Science, Social Service & Education Grant Program:

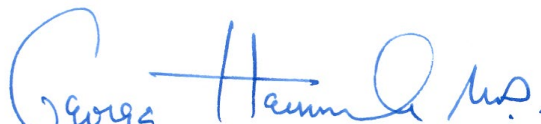
