Eligibility is limited to Rutgers Ph.D. students whose major area of research involves one or more of the following dimensions of climate change and renewable energy or energy conservation scholarship:

- Earth system science
- Human dimensions of climate mitigation, adaptation, and resilience
- Renewable energy, technology, and energy conservation
- Climate change communication and environmental humanities

The fund provides support to enable Rutgers Ph.D. students to participate in conferences, workshops, symposia, professional meetings, field activities, and visits to federal or state agencies or universities for educational or research purposes. Eligible expenses include attendance fees, lodging, meals, and transportation. The maximum award for any one student will be \$1,500 unless special circumstances can be identified by

the student's faculty mentor.

Students who have received funding through this program in the past are eligible to apply. Awards will be made based on available funds and number of applicants. Priority will be given to students who have not received funds in the past.
